Each parish will be levied by **Kilmore Diocese** at the rate of 11% of the accumulated 2008 Parish Offertory Collections which will work out at a contribution of

**€5,005** from **Dromahair**, **€ 3,066** from **Killargue** & **€2,503** from **Newtownmanor**.

**A contribution of at least €10 per household would be needed to make up even half the amount due.**
