On Vigil of Feast ~ Wednesday 14th August: Newtownmanor ~ **7.00pm;** Killargue ~ **8.00pm.**

On the Feast Day ~ Thursday 15th August: Dromahair ~ **11.15am & 8.00pm;** Killargue Holy Well ~ **6.00pm.**

The **Mass at the Holy Well** takes place at **6.00pm** on the **Feast Day itself ~ Thursday 15th August.**

This is a **Special Mass for The Gathering** and it is also the **Month's Memory Mass** for **Fr. John Flanagan** who was a faithful celebrant of this Mass annually. People with mobility difficulties are asked to be very careful at the Holy Well, especially in wet conditions. Should weather be extremely wet, Mass will be transferred to the church.
