# **COVID 19 – LATEST NEWS**

The Government has announced that with effect from Monday 6<sup>th</sup> September and subject to continued protective factors, all religious ceremonies can proceed with 50% of venue capacity, regardless of immunity status of attendees. From <u>Friday 22nd October</u> onwards, final restrictions will be lifted including restrictions on religious ceremonies.

Due to the continuing requirement to maintain social distancing relative to the space available in our churches, there will be little change to the current arrangements, up to 22nd October. Face coverings should also continue to be worn in this interim period.

<u>The Season of Creation</u> is celebrated this year from 1st September to 4th October. It provides an opportunity to respond to Pope Francis' 2015 Encyclical Letter on the environment, Laudato Si': on care for our common home, the title of which is taken from the canticle of St Francis of Assisi: 'Laudato Si', mi' Signore (Praise be to you, my Lord).

The following 10 commandments have been issued by the Kilmore Laudato Si' Group to help us protect our environment (Some very interesting facts for us all to keep in mind):

- 1. Stop using plastic bottles. It takes 3 litres of water to produce a 1 litre bottle of water. Drink tap water instead. If necessary, use a filter jug. Keep a jug of water in the fridge instead of waiting for the tap to run cold.
- 2. Don't just throw things away. It takes 2,700 litres of water to make a single cotton T-shirt.
- 3. Don't covet the latest mobile phone. There is up to 30 times more gold in a tonne of old mobile phones than in a tonne of gold ore.
- 4. Wash laundry at 30 C if possible. It cuts CO2 emissions and saves energy.
- 5. Boil only the amount of water you need. It saves on energy, time and electricity costs.
- 6. Reduce driving speed. You save on fuel and reduce emissions of other pollutants from diesel vehicles.
- 7. Don't leave electrical appliances on standby. Switch off.
- 8. Use double sided paper. It takes more energy to make 1kg of paper than it takes to make 1kg of steel
- 9. Check your font size! Switching from Arial to Century Gothic saves 30% printing ink.
