Do not throw discarded items into the ditches or into the grass where they are an absolute danger to those doing strimming and maintenance.

**And please do not let your dog off the lead in or near the cemeteries.** The Cemetery area and individual graves are constantly being fouled by dogs when people take them for a walk and let them loose where they should not be. We need to have more respect for the dead and their relatives who maintain the graves.
