MMR = Measles, Mumps & Rubella. Measles illness is on the increase in Ireland so protection with MMR is important. These vaccines are free from your GP in the North West. If your child has not received these two vaccines, please arrange an appointment with your GP. It is never too late to catch up on missed vaccinations.
