**Diocese of Kilmore & Parish of Drumlease - Killargue: Swine Flu Advice.**

Swine Flu – A (H1N1) – is highly contagious & is transmitted

- (a) Largely person to person, spread by droplets from the respiratory secretions of infected individuals.
- (b) By contact with contaminated surfaces.

Because of the method of contamination it is important not to sneeze or cough into other people's space or face. Use disposable tissues if coughing or sneezing & dispose of them as soon as ever possible.

Clean hands are vital too. Keep them clean!

The diocese recommends: 1. That all those who have flu symptoms should not attend church services.

2. That clergy & ministers of the Eucharist use hospital type sanitizer.

3. That people read the HSE guidelines regarding precautions to take. Remember the HSE booklet sent to you?

And the parish has decided that (i): We will dispense with the sign of peace for the time being.

(ii): That all should receive Holy Communion in the hand to prevent cross contamination.
