#### Tax Relief for Donations to Eligible Charities and Approved Bodies.

Under this <u>Tax Relief Scheme</u> our parish is eligible to claim back a percentage of the tax paid by parishioners on their church contributions: all collections and dues.

If you are a PAYE worker and contribute to your parish, please take home a copy of the **CHY2 Cert** ~ a **white Revenue Form** ~ which you'll find at the back of your church.

Fill in the relevant sections according to the instructions in the <u>letter from the parish</u>, which accompanies it ~ <u>a yellow page</u>. Thanks for your help and continuing generosity!

Any tax repaid by Revenue goes to Parish Funds and not to the priests.

It is vital to return forms this week ~ since time to claim is now very limited.
