MMR = Measles, Mumps & Rubella. Measles illness is on the increase in Ireland so protection with MMR is important. These vaccines are free from your GP in the North West. If your child has not received these two vaccines, please arrange an appointment with your GP. It is never too late to catch up on missed vaccinations. ### **Important Notice for all our Church & Parish Volunteers**

As part of the new **Data Protection Legislation (GDPR)** governing Ireland, the Parish is required to keep a record of your written consent to process your personal data. Your personal data includes your name, address, mobile/landline telephone number, email address, etc. Personal data is kept by the Parish: (1) In order to publish your name in the Parish Newsletter, or on Church Noticeboards or on the Parish Website and (2) In order to contact you from time to time with regard to the voluntary roles/ministries that you are involved in. **The above applies to all; Ministers of the Word, Choir Members, Door/Offertory Collectors, Ministers of Holy Communion, Altar Society Members, Parish Pastoral Council & Parish Finance Committee Members.** Parents of Altar Servers will be contacted separately by the Parish Safeguarding Representative, where necessary.
