'Making Decisions and Preparing for the Future Together' - Bishop Martin Hayes

On Monday the 6th of November, parishioners from all three church areas gathered in St. Patricks Church, Dromahair, to discuss three key questions raised in relation to the Bishop Martin's letter.

<u>There were discussions around</u>: The future of the Faith, Skills and Roles required of a Parish Pastoral Worker and Preparation for rescheduling Masses in our Pastoral Area.

The key points raised at the meeting will be fed back to the Diocese to ensure that our parish views are heard. Some of these concerns include:

- Availability of Masses/Sacraments/Ceremonies/Priests and loss of Community spirit and faith traditions. The importance of people becoming more involved in their parish.
- It was suggested that the skills required of a Pastoral worker would include; leadership, communication, empathy, kindness, public speaking, having a strong faith and knowledge of catechism and scripture.

- Fr Paul reflected on the importance of using our Church, if we don't, we will lose it.
