Diocese of Kilmore & Parish of Drumlease - Killarque: Swine Flu Advice.

Swine Flu – A (H1N1) – is highly contagious & is transmitted

- (a) Largely person to person, spread by droplets from the respiratory secretions of infected individuals.(b) By contact with contaminated surfaces.
- Because of the method of contamination it is important not to sneeze or cough into other people's space or face. Use disposable tissues if coughing or sneezing & dispose of them as soon as ever possible.

 Clean hands are vital too. Keep them clean!
- The diocese recommends: 1. That all those who have flu symptoms should not attend church services.

 2. That clergy & ministers of the Eucharist use hospital type sanitizer.
- 3. That people read the HSE guidelines regarding precautions to take. Remember the HSE booklet sent to you?
 - And the parish has decided that (i): We will dispense with the sign of peace for the time being.

 (ii): That all should receive Holy Communion in the hand to prevent cross contamination.
