### **Archbishop Eamon Martin, Archbishop of Armagh and Primate of All Ireland has called for a Family Rosary Crusade against Covid-19 during the month of October**

**TODAY IS WORLD MISSION SUNDAY:** Paying tribute to our missionaries- Mission Sunday gives us an opportunity to pray for the missionaries from Ireland, both living and deceased, who left this country to spread the Gospel. We honour and remember these generous and courageous priests, sisters, brothers and lay people at Masses on Mission Sunday. Being missionaries at home several years ago, ***St John Paul II***, asked all lay people to become missionaries to their own families and in their own parishes.

Later, ***Pope Benedict XVI*** wrote that *“faith is strengthened when it is given to others”*. He also said that *“today’s tendency to relegate faith to the private sphere contradicts its very nature”*: ***faith is given to be shared, not hidden away***. Pope Francis has put this message at the centre of his pontificate, calling upon all of us to become **“missionary disciples of Jesus”**. New encyclical by Pope Francis- Inspired by the example of St Francis of Assisi and the Good Samaritan, the Pope urges us to find new ways to put social solidarity and care before fear and self-interest. The timing of this letter from the Pope could not be more apt.
