This adds up to well over €120,000 per year for our Diocese alone.  
Each parish is levied by **Kilmore Diocese** in accordance with its population ~ a contribution of €4 per head this year for every man, woman and child in the 3 parish areas ~ a total of €12 for a household of three.
