On Wednesday next - 2nd November we Commemorate in a special way, All the Faithful Departed. Mass times are as follows: Dromahair at 11.15am; NEWTOWNMANOR ON THURSDAY 3<sup>rd</sup> NOVEMBER AT 8.00PM.

November List of the Dead: November is a month that we remember our faithful departed in a very special way. There will be 12 special Masses celebrated in the parish for this intention. Envelopes are available in your box of parish envelopes, or you can write you own list and place in an envelope marked 'List of our Dead'. Please complete and return to be included. Thanks.

## November – The month dedicated to the Holy Souls in Purgatory

The month of Nov is a time when we remember and pray for our deceased loved ones. It is a work of mercy to pray for the Holy Souls in Purgatory. We can do this by doing the following:

From 12.00 noon on the 1<sup>st</sup> November until midnight on 2<sup>nd</sup> November, all who have confessed, received Holy Communion and prayed for the Pope's intention [one Our Father and one Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice], can gain a plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory, and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostles Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the faithful departed.

Confessions may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week after the 1<sup>st</sup> Nov. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> of November. A plenary indulgence, again applicable only to the Holy Souls is also granted to the faithful who visit a cemetery and there pray for the departed from the 1<sup>st</sup>- 8<sup>th</sup> of Nov. On other days of the year, it is a partial indulgence. Another partial indulgence is gained for the Holy Souls each time we recite the Eternal Rest Prayer.

Small wooden crosses: Will be left beside our list of our dead. You are invited to take one home and during this month, let it be a gentle reminder to pray and remember our faithful departed and especially the holy souls in purgatory and those who have no one to remember them. Thanks.

FIRST FRIDAY'S - 4<sup>th</sup> November: Fr Paul will visit the sick and housebound at usual times this Friday. If there is anybody who would like a visit, please let him Fr Paul know. Thanks.

A Gentle Reminder: As we are now in the last quarter of the year, could I ask that the Dues & Offertory Collections for 2022 are brought up to date before the end of the year. Parishioners will receive a statement of their 2022 payments to the parish, in the new year. However, only amounts received in the calendar year of 2022, will be included in this statement.
